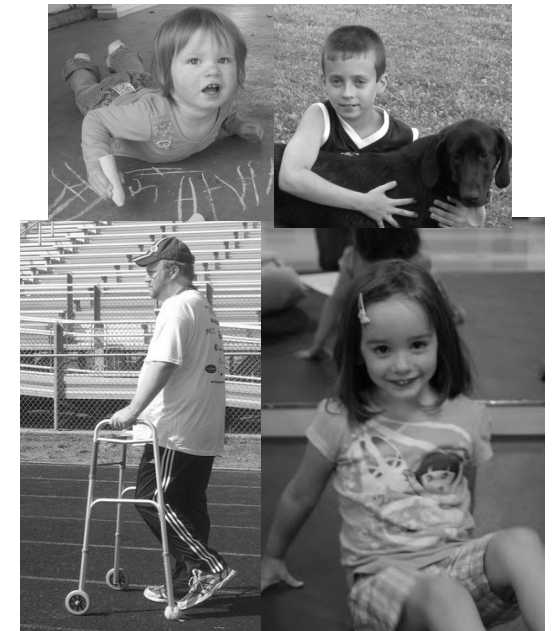
How can you help

Chiari Malformation is a structural defect in the cerebellum. The cerebellum is the part of the brain that controls balance. Chiari is pronounced as Kee-AR-ee and was coined by Hans Chiari, an Austrian pathologist, in the early 1890s. Chiari Malformation Type I is the most common type of Chiari Malformation. Chiari occurs when the lower part of the brain, called the tonsils of the cerebellum, partly descends into the spinal canal and interrupts the flow of the cerebrospinal fluid, which can cause numerous symptoms.

Who we are

Wishes and Rainbows is a non-profit, 501 (c)(3) established in May of 2002. Most of the officers are affected by these conditions, or have a family member who is. We are all dedicated to helping those with Chiari, Syringomyelia, and other related disorders.
